## A. COMMUNITY BASED ACTIVITIES:

The following three community based activities will be free of charge and are part of the alternate environment curriculum. As this is part of our PHE courses, students are expected to fully participate. If they can't participate for medical reasons, teachers need to be informed by note or email. - 1. <u>Skating:</u> All students will walk to Kensington Arena to participate in ice skating once a month from November to February. Helmets and ice skates are provided free of charge if students do not have their own.
- 2. <u>Swimming:</u> All grade 8 and 9 students will walk to the Kensington Pool during June for 4 classes to swim and play in the pool, supervised by teachers and life guards. The pool is shallow enough to stand up in.
- 3. <u>Community Runs and hikes:</u> Students may leave the school grounds to go for short runs and hikes in the direct community.
